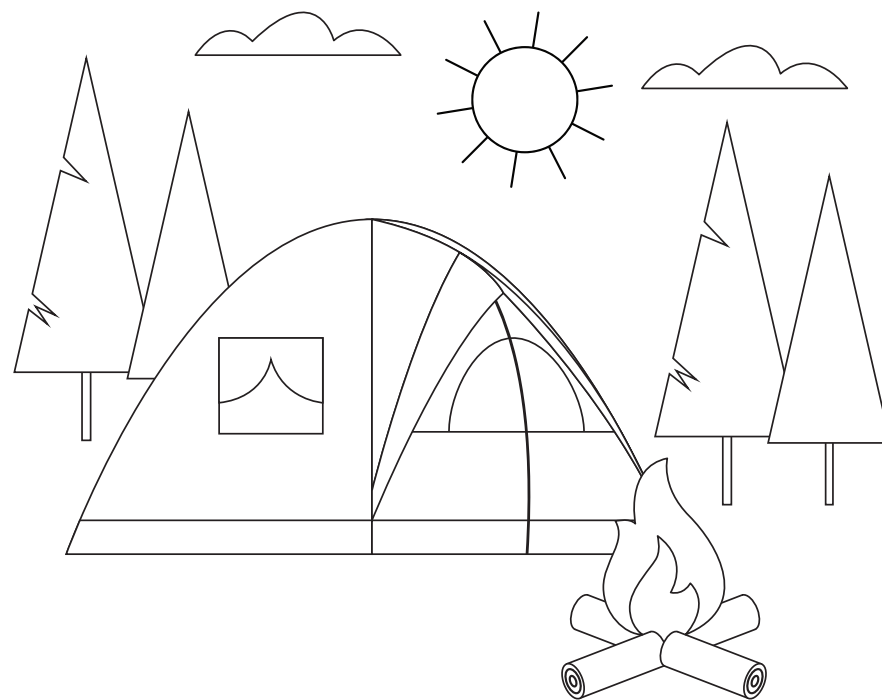
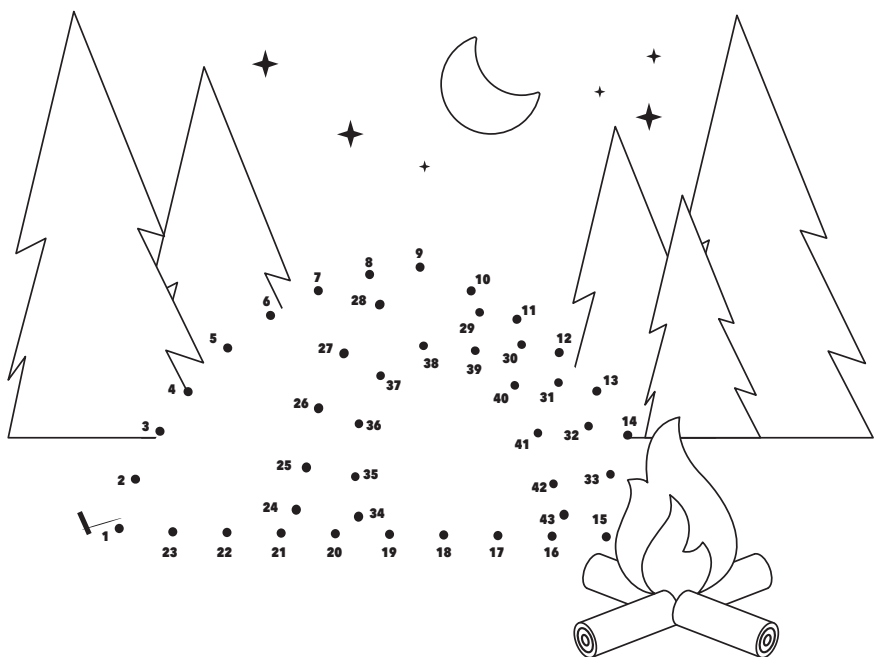
## TIPS FOR YOUR BACKYARD CAMP

- Bring your Springfree Backyard Camping Kit to the campsite. This activity book is a great way for the kids to start out the day at the campsite or while you finish setting up.
- Prepare all extra supplies you may need for a night in the backyard - Sleeping bags, pillow, snacks, water and batteries for your mini lantern.
- Before backyard camping, inspect the campsite for insect nests & large branches fallen & overhead.
- String the solar powered lights onto your trampoline or in the backyard to add more light to your campsite.
- Setup the tent provided before the kiddos arrive to camp. The setup is easy, but make sure if children are present, to have them stand back, 3-5ft away from the tent while it is being opened and setup.
- Always have adult supervision if there is a campfire or fire pit. Always pitch the tent a safe distance from a fire.
- Be sure to have your blanket and lantern ready for when the sun goes down.
- Have the home first-aid kit handy.
- Always keep the tent & campsite clean. Have the kids help out with this one!
