

PRODUCT CARE

- Always store in a dry place and out of the sun.
- Regularly check that the ball, rope and all connections are in good condition.
- Regularly check the composite poles for damage. If damage is observed do not play.
- Dirt and debris inside the score counter can be washed out carefully using a garden hose.

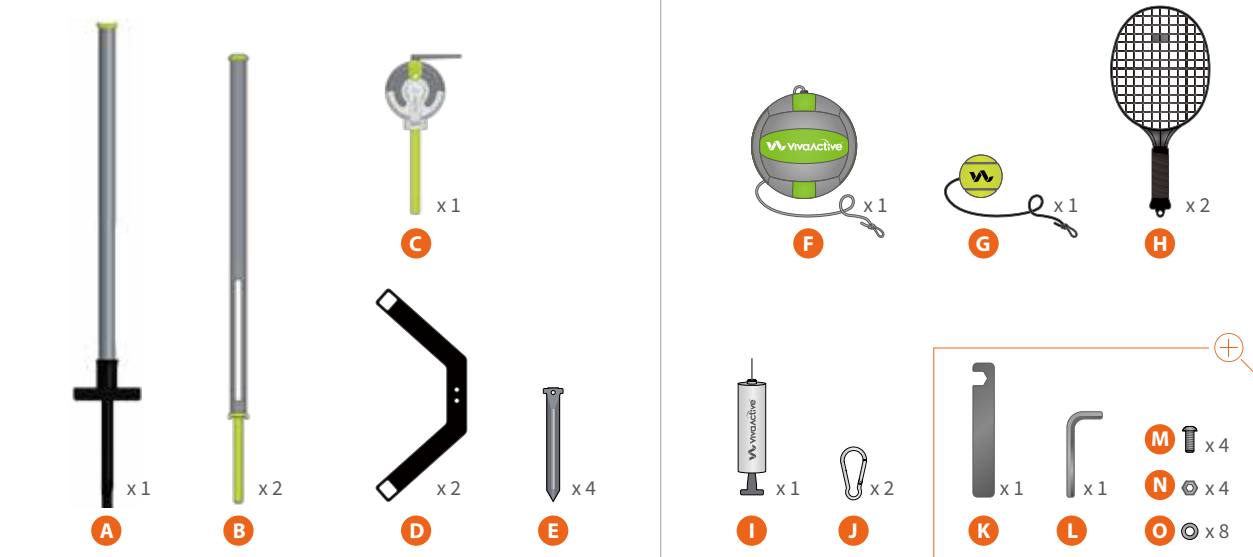
WARNING!

- Before installation, check for underground power, gas, telephone, water, and other utility lines and pipes. Failure to do so may result in serious or fatal injury.
- Not recommended for children under 6 years of age. Choking hazard – small parts. Use only with mature, knowledgeable supervision. Ensure all safety rules. Keep face and body clear of any moving parts.
- Impact from high velocity balls can cause facial injuries. Entanglement with the rope may cause strangulation and serious injury.

CAUTION

- Before assembly, read these instructions completely. Lay out and identify all components against the parts list below.
- Never hammer the base into the ground. Use foot pressure only, applied directly over the bolts.
- Install on a soft, flat and level playing area. This product is not suitable for paved surfaces. Maintain a safe clearance zone of 15 ft (4.5 m) diameter around the base.
- Use only the included balls and connections. Non-specified accessories may cause damage to the score counter and poles.
- Swing Ball is played using the included tennis ball and paddles.
- Tetherball is played using the included volley ball. Strike the volley ball with your hands, making a fist or with flat palms. Keep fingers away from the ball to avoid injury.
- Do not climb on or pull hard on the poles. Doing so may damage the poles.
- Use only supplied or Viva Active branded parts and accessories. Use of any other kind of accessory is not recommended and may cause injury or damage.

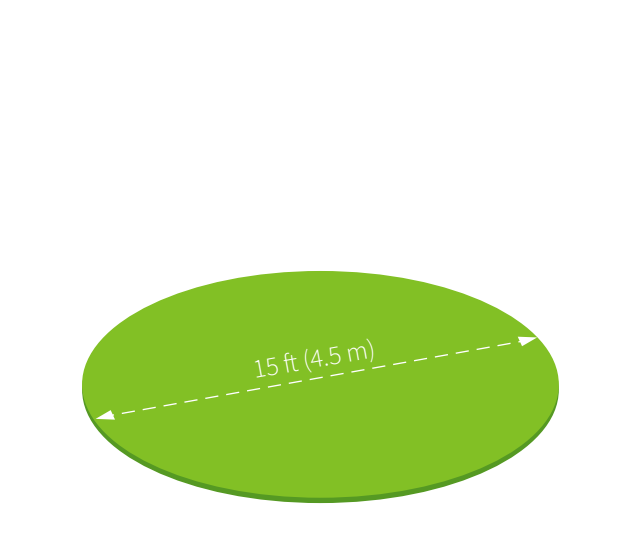

2 ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS: BASE



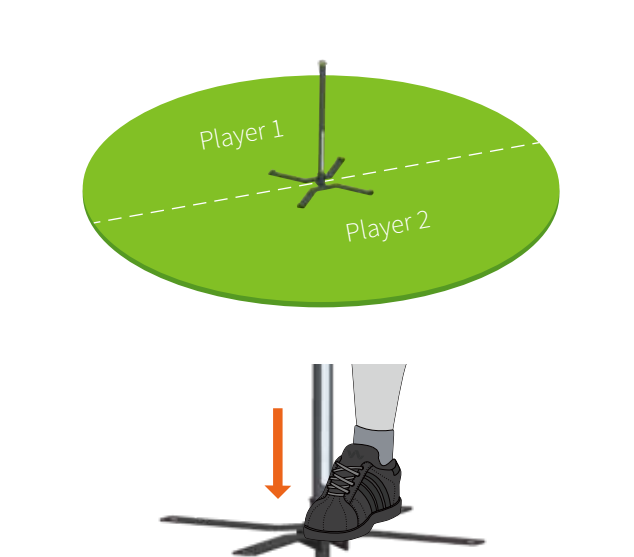
- Take the base pole and attach both anchor plates using the bolts, nuts and washers.
TIP – Use the wrench and hex key provided.

3 ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS: BASE



- Find a soft, flat and level playing area. Ensure a safe clearance zone of 15 ft (4.5 m) diameter.
WARNING - Before installation, check for underground power, gas, telephone, water, and other utility lines and pipes. Failure to do so may result in serious or fatal injury.

4 ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS: BASE



- Secure the spiked end of the base pole into the ground, in the centre of the clearance zone. Use foot pressure only, applied directly over the bolts. Orientate the base as shown to define the area of play.
WARNING - Using a mallet or hammer will damage the base pole.

5 ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS: BASE



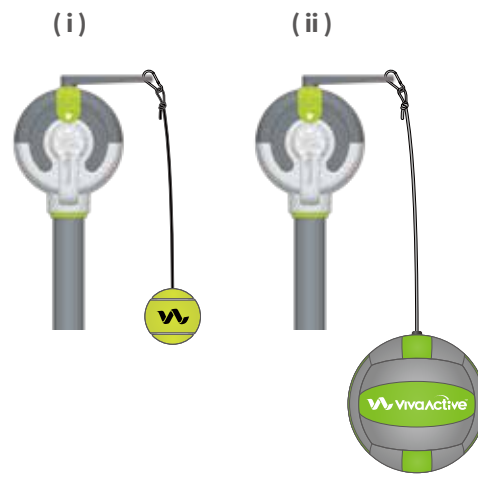
- Take one of the anchor pegs and secure it vertically into the ground, through one of the rectangular holes in the anchor plates. Ensure the underside of the peg is flush with the top of the anchor plate.
- Repeat for the other three pegs.
TIP – A rubber mallet may be used to hammer the peg into the ground.

6 ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS: SCORE COUNTER



- Take the score counter and locate it into the top of one of the upper poles.
- Align the tabs and push down on the score counter to clip together.
- Reset the score counter as shown in the 'HOW TO PLAY' section.

7 ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS: BALLS



- Attach the desired ball to the score counter arm using one of the included carabiners; feed the carabiner through the loop at the end of the rope, then through the opening in the score counter arm. The following ball options are available:
 - Swing Ball:** tennis ball
 - Tetherball:** volley ball

8 ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS: POLES



- For **Swing Ball**, locate the score counter and upper pole assembly directly into the top of the base pole (i). Align the tabs and push down to clip together.
- For **Tetherball**, locate the score counter and upper pole assembly into the top of the remaining upper pole (ii). Align the tabs and push down to clip together. Now locate this assembly into the top of the base Pole (iii). Align the tabs and push down to clip together.

9 HOW TO PLAY: RESET



- Move both flags on the score counter to the vertical START position; the two triangles will be aligned.
- Flags can be moved by hand, or by spinning the score counter arm.

10 HOW TO PLAY: GAMEPLAY



- Get your flag to the FINISH position to win (either left or right).
- Hitting the ball to your left will move your flag counter-clockwise.
- Hitting the ball to your right will move your flag clockwise.
- One complete revolution of the ball will move your flag one point closer to your finish position while your opponent's flag will move one point away from their finish position.

11 HOW TO PLAY: SHORT GAME



- You can shorten the game by offsetting both flags an even amount toward each player's finish position. The dots are spaced at 5 point increments.

12 HOW TO PLAY: PLAYER ADVANTAGE



- Move a player's flag closer to their finish position before starting the game to give them an advantage, or away from their finish position to give them a disadvantage.

13 HOW TO PLAY: FREE PLAY



- Once the flags have reached the finish point the game can still be played. Great for continuous play or training.

This limited warranty is subject to the following terms:

 - Accessories purchased from an unauthorized dealer.
 - Improper installation not in accordance with the provided assembly instructions.

 - Repairs or alterations carried out by unauthorized parties or agents.
